What lighting can do

Designed by Charlotte Rowe, this terrace is made for London living : no trade off allowed.



Clean architectural lines and interesting planting bring the chic feel whilst the lighting allows the place to shift gears and provide a great party setting.

The lighting designed by Rebecca Weir at Light IQ achieves this using LED.

"Pink LED rope light set within a shadow gap beneath the planters creating strong lines and visual definition to the space. White LED's are set beneath the glass steps to bring them to life at night. The advantage of LED's is that they are cool to touch and have exceptionally long lamp life, up to 50,000 hours ensuring minimum maintenance for the next 5-10 years. Low voltage lights were used for subtle accentuation of the planting, bringing to life the movement and texture of the foliage. This is a minimal lighting scheme with maximum impact. The clients are delighted as they can change the feel of the space from subtle with focus on planting, to a dramatic party setting."
